

DEFINITIONS FOR AN ACT OF GOD AND FORCE MAJEURE

An “Act of God” and/or “Force Majeure” means an event beyond the control of Performing Arts Workshops and prevents PAW from performing its duties, functions, services in a normal manner or in the manner as advertised. An Act of God is typically characterized as a naturally occurring phenomena like natural disasters. These can include but are not limited to: earthquakes, fires, tsunamis, floods, hurricanes, pandemics, volcanoes. A Force Majeure event is typically a man-made occurrence. They can include but are not limited to: riots, civil unrest, war, strikes, lockouts, power outages, power grid failures, internet outages, government-mandated business closures.
